- learned a lot about it : how many square kilometers it covers and particularly interesting was the history of the tragedy that occurred in 2018, when bark beetles destroyed about three-quarters of the spruce trees.**
 - We also learned why there are both mixed and monoculture forests in Brilon, what roles the animals play in the forest, and why they are so important.**
